**Please read this essential information before completing the form**

**ROUTES:** There is a choice of a **short route of 4k [2.5miles]** or the **traditional route 7.4k [4.6miles]**. The short route is primarily for primary school children and the cups for that age group will be awarded to the first three children on this route. Parents, fancy dress walkers and any others may also take the shorter route, if they wish. For secondary school children and adults, the traditional route is retained as the main challenge and cups will be awarded to the fastest entrants on that route. However, either route is available for each entrant. Please select your choice to help us with the marshalling on the day.

**REGISTRATION:** all entrants, including those in fancy dress, walkers of either route must complete an entry form in full, make the appropriate payment and sign the disclaimer statement. This form can be used or done online at [www.sawstonfunrun.co.uk](http://www.sawstonfunrun.co.uk) Registrations can also be made on the day but the fees are more; see Entry Fees below.

**ON-LINE ENTRY:** this easy and trouble-free feature is available on the website. The closing date for **online** entries is Friday 11<sup>th</sup> May at 6.00pm.

Enclose a cheque or postal order payable to 'Sawston Fun Run' for the entry fees. Postal entries must be received by the 5<sup>th</sup> May to ensure you receive your entry pack before the event.

[Online registrations will receive an email providing instructions for the event and notification of their vest number, which will need to be collected on the 14<sup>th</sup> May from the pre-event registration area].

**SPONSORSHIP INFORMATION:** the sponsorship form has spaces for sponsors. **ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:** each entrant must wear their vest number for safety and administration reasons. Entrants are advised to prepare themselves by training beforehand and to seek medical advice if there are any doubts about fitness.

**TROPHIES and CERTIFICATES:** The first three runners in every category will receive a trophy; for the school years 1-6 category the race route is the short 4k one. Everyone will receive a certificate and school years 1-11 will receive a medal.
